






- 1. Mark up the door at your desired location, noting the overall diameter of the flush pull is D82mm or D3 $^{7}/_{32}$ ".
- 2. Using a 76mm or 3" hole saw, cut into the door to a depth of 13mm or 1/2".
- 3. Carefully chisel out the internal of the hole until level.
- **4.** Gently sand back the edges of the hole to allow for the flush pull lip. Figure 1.



5. Apply your preferred adhesive in the hole and gently push the flush pull in, being careful not to over apply the adhesive.
Position the flush pull so that its fitted in the direction the door will slide to open. Figure 2.



**6.** If installing back-to-back (two flush pull required) repeat steps 1-5.
